


2024 SALEM RETREAT

To help you choose, I have compiled a list of hotels with varying prices that are conveniently located within walking distance of our scheduled activities. TOURS AND SCHEDULED ACTIVITIES



Salem Witch Trials Historical Walking Tour

- 1. Haunted Footsteps & Salem Historical Tours Examine the demographics, theories and personal stories comprising the dire events of 1692. We will bring you to many of the locations that are full of witch trial history. Many of the structures are long since gone except for a few, but we know where they were located. This is a fascinating tour that will shed new light on what happened during the infamous witchcraft hysteria which turned neighbor against neighbor.
- 2. Salem Witch Trials Memorial. Dedicated in 1992, this bench style memorial is in remembrance for the 20 innocent victims of the 1692 Salem Witchcraft Trials 15 minutes Admission Ticket Free
- 3. Rockafellas: Now a popular restaurant located in the center of historic Salem, Rockafellas or the Daniel Low and Co. building was the original site of the First Church of Salem, as well as the city meeting house in 1692
- 4. Joshua Ward House: Now the Merchant Hotel this is the site where George Corwin's house once stood. He was the High Sheriff of Essex County in 1692, as such, responsible for signing arrest and execution warrants of the innocent victims of the trials.
- 5. Witch House: The only remaining Salem structure with direct ties to the witch trials of 1692.

The Salem Night Tour

Salem Night Tour Take a spooky stroll through downtown Salem, Massachusetts on this haunt and history, night walking tour. Join the adventure Friday and Saturday at 8pm or Sunday through Thursday at 6pm. Starting April 1st, we will be running every night at 8pm! Licensed guides lead the way through legends, history, and the infamous hysteria of 1692 — the Salem Witch Trials. This is a walking tour of historic downtown Salem that lasts about 90 minutes. Hear amazing stories of Salem's past and discover why Salem is one of the most beloved, historic, and haunted towns in America. The route goes at a comfortable pace, rain or shine.

1. Salem Witch Trials Memorial

Salem Witch Trials memorial featuring a series of inscribed stones throughout the burial ground.

2. Salem Old Town Hall

guests will hear about Salem's movie history and see one of the iconic filming locations of the movie Hocus Pocus

3. Old Burying Point Cemetery

Pass by the cemetery and look into it from the gates as you hear about Salem's most spooky ghosts

- 4. Saint Peter's Episcopal Church enter the back garden area of one of Salem's oldest churches, and walk on the unmarked Puritan graves beneath as you hear about the dark history and ghost stories associated with the Salem Witch Trials of 1692.
- 5. Essex Street Pedestrian Mall (Pass By)

Pass through the epicenter of historic Salem filled with shopping, sightseeing and history.
